15. Multidisciplinary / interdisciplinary

Raja Madhusudan Dev Degree College, Patia affiliated with Utkal University, has been proactive in transforming itself into a holistic multidisciplinary institution, despite following the university's prescribed syllabus. The institution goes beyond the academic curriculum by focusing on skill development and community engagement. One notable initiative is the establishment of a skill development training center by the Department of Home Science, offering tailoring training to both students and women from nearby villages. This initiative serves a dual purpose by empowering the local community, particularly women, with valuable skills that can improve their economic independence. The college has also signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Samvedana Foundation under "Project Vidya", which provides free primary education to underprivileged children from the nearby adopted village. This initiative is supported by the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of the institution, ensuring that the children receive a foundational education. In addition, the mothers of these children are given tailoring training at the skill development center, thus creating a sustainable and holistic approach to community development. Furthering its interdisciplinary approach, the institution has an MoU to run a Computer Training Center, offering affordable basic computer education to its students. This program equips students with essential digital literacy, ensuring they are prepared for the modern workforce. The college also adheres to Utkal University's Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) syllabus, which incorporates project work in areas such as community engagement, environmental education, and value-based learning. These projects are designed to provide final-year students, especially those who excel academically, with practical, real-world experience while fostering a sense of responsibility towards society and the environment. Through these diverse initiatives, Raja Madhusudan Dev Degree College, Patia is making significant strides toward becoming a multidisciplinary institution that integrates skill development, social responsibility, and academic excellence.

16. Academic bank of credits (ABC):

Raja Madhusudan Dev Degree College, Patia affiliated with Utkal University, follows the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) syllabus, which was introduced in the academic year 2015-16. The CBCS framework includes core courses, discipline-specific electives (DSEs), ability enhancement compulsory courses (AECC), skill enhancement courses (SECs), and generic electives (GEs). The ABC complements the CBCS by offering students additional

flexibility in designing their academic journeys and transferring credits across institutions as needed. Students at Raja Madhusudan Dev Degree College, Patia are encouraged to participate in the ABC system and are made aware of its benefits. By creating an Academic Bank of Credits account, or an APAAR ID, students can access a variety of academic services, such as credit verification, accumulation, transfer, and the authentication of academic awards. The ABC platform, accessible through abc.gov.in, allows students to store and manage their academic credits across multiple programs or institutions, making it easier for them to pursue interdisciplinary studies or switch institutions without losing their earned credits. This initiative empowers students with greater academic freedom, helping them tailor their education to their specific interests and career goals. The ABC system, combined with the CBCS syllabus, plays a vital role in transforming higher education in India by fostering a more holistic, flexible, and learner-focused academic environment. Raja Madhusudan Dev Degree College's promotion of the ABC system reflects its commitment to adapting to the evolving needs of its students.

17.Skill development:

Raja Madhusudan Dev Degree College, while adhering to the prescribed syllabus of Utkal University, has made significant strides in offering skill development courses that extend beyond the traditional academic framework. The institution emphasizes practical learning to complement theoretical knowledge, particularly through its Department of Home Science. A sewing machine in the home science lab allows students to learn garment-making techniques, equipping them with practical skills that are both personally enriching and professionally valuable. They also make Cusines mela where the students prepare different cuisines. In addition to the skill development opportunities offered by the Home Science department, the college provides various platforms for students to enhance their skills through extracurricular activities. The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit, Scout and Guide unit, Red Cross unit, and National Cadet Corps (NCC) play a pivotal role in this regard. These units encourage students to participate in community service and awareness drives, which help them develop leadership, teamwork, and social responsibility. Students actively engage in events

such as International Women's Day, Yoga Day, traffic awareness rallies, plantation drives, blood donation camps, and first aid camps. These activities not only foster a sense of civic duty but also equip students with practical skills like event management, public speaking, and first aid. The institution's commitment to holistic development is further highlighted by the numerous awards received by students and their trainers for their contributions to these initiatives. These accolades underscore the effectiveness of the college's approach to integrating skill development into the academic experience. By offering a blend of practical training through the Home Science department and extracurricular engagement through NSS, Scout and Guide, Red Cross, and NCC units, Raja Madhusudan Dev Degree College ensures that its students graduate with a well-rounded education. This focus on skill development helps students become more adaptable and prepared for the diverse challenges of the workforce and society.

In addition to this, the integration of technology through Utkal University's

Virtual Tutorial Project (VTP) further strengthens the academic framework. Video tutorials are prepared in a bilingual format, ensuring that students can comprehend the material with ease. This initiative bridges the gap between traditional and modern methods of learning, allowing students to benefit from online resources while maintaining a strong connection to their linguistic and cultural roots. These spaces, along with free WiFi available throughout the campus, enable both students and teachers to access online resources, conduct virtual classes, and participate in webinars, workshops, or other online educational activities. The college's preparedness for online education proved especially crucial during the COVID-19 pandemic, when physical classes were suspended. Leveraging the available online platforms, smart classrooms, and virtual tools, the college successfully transitioned to remote teaching, ensuring that students' learning was not disrupted during the lockdown period. The college follows the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and prepares its academic calendar based on the university schedule. 2.2 - Catering to Student Diversity

2.2.1 - The institution assesses the learning levels of the students and organizes special Programmes for advanced learners and slow learners

Raja Madhusudan Dev Degree College is committed to supporting all students, considering their economic background and language differences. Initially, students may hesitate to interact, but faculty members actively monitor their learning levels through various methods like induction programs, class participation, assignments, mind games, debates, and problem-solving sessions. Faculty members identify slow and advanced learners based on their classroom engagement and performance in class tests. Slow learners receive additional support through remedial classes, online revision sessions, and seminars. Special tests and audio aids in the vernacular language are also provided. Fast learners are assigned self-study topics, self-learning courses, and encouraged to engage in activities like debates, research webinars, creative writing, and entrepreneurship programs. The college follows the semester system under Utkal University's Choice Based Credit System. Students scoring 60% and above are classified as fast learners and can undertake projects in their final year. Those scoring between 45-50% receive extra care from mentors. For Science students in Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Mathematics and Arts students in Education and Home Science, a practical learning is emphasized through group-based experiments in laboratories and fieldwork. At RMD Degree College, the mechanism for internal assessment is transparent, structured, and follows the guidelines set by Utkal University. The college conducts Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) to assess students' academic progress through a combination of written tests, assignments, projects, and presentations. The assessment schedule, including test dates, submission deadlines, and evaluation criteria, is shared with students well in advance through notice boards, WhatsApp groups, and direct communication with faculty members.

The internal assessments are conducted twice each semester. The first assessment typically includes quizzes, assignments, or class tests, while the second focuses on mid-term exams. In addition, for practical subjects, students are evaluated based on their laboratory performance and viva-voce. The evaluation process is transparent, with answer scripts and feedback provided to students to help them understand their mistakes and improve. Marks from internal assessments contribute significantly to the final grade in each subject as per the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The college ensures that the assessments are conducted fairly and uniformly across all departments, with periodic reviews by the Heads of Departments (HoDs) to maintain consistency and reliability. This robust system ensures that students are continuously engaged in learning and receive timely feedback on their performance.

2.5.2 - Mechanism to deal with internal examination related grievances is transparent, time- bound and efficient

RMD Degree College has a transparent, time-bound, and efficient mechanism to address internal examination-related grievances. The process is designed to ensure fairness and quick resolution of student concerns. Students can raise grievances regarding their internal assessments, such as discrepancies in marks, improper evaluation, or missing grades, directly with their subject teachers or Heads of Departments (HoDs). Upon receiving a grievance, the faculty reviews the student's complaint by rechecking the answer scripts and cross-verifying marks awarded. If the issue is not resolved at the department level, the student can escalate the matter to the Internal Examination Grievance Committee, which includes senior faculty members and the Examination In-Charge. This committee thoroughly investigates the grievance and ensures that any error in evaluation is rectified without delay. The timeline for resolving such grievances is kept minimal, usually within 7 to 10 working days, to ensure that students can focus on their studies without prolonged anxiety. Feedback is promptly provided to the concerned student, and if necessary, revised marks are updated in the official records.

This structured approach ensures a smooth, efficient process for resolving grievances, maintaining the integrity of the internal assessment system and fostering trust between students and faculty.

Raja Madhusudhan Dev Degree College was established in the 1993-94 academic session by local residents and the governing body of the Junior College. The campus features two main gates and includes a cafeteria and a branch of Punjab National Bank. It provides well-structured and secure parking for staff and students, enhanced by a 360-degree camera at the main gate and 71 CCTV cameras across the premises. The college aims to foster a conducive learning atmosphere while contributing to environmental sustainability, boasting a well-maintained botanical garden surrounded by trees.

The campus consists of three main blocks: the Arts Block, Science Block, and a four-pillar building, housing 20 classrooms, three

The library features 13 racks catering to all departments, with online access and functional computers to support students' learning. The college includes five seminar halls, varying in capacity from 50 to 350, all equipped with projectors and AC. Additionally, seven laboratories facilitate hands-on learning. Sports facilities, including a basketball court and a football field, promote student engagement in physical activities. Overall, the college emphasizes a holistic educational experience.

Slow learners receive additional support through remedial classes, online revision sessions, and seminars. Special tests and audio aids in the vernacular language are also provided. Fast learners are assigned self-study topics, self-learning courses, and encouraged to engage in activities like debates, research webinars, creative writing, and entrepreneurship programs. The college follows the semester system under Utkal University's Choice Based Credit System. Students scoring 60% and above are classified as fast learners and can undertake projects in their final year. Those scoring between 45-50% receive extra care from mentors. Students are also encouraged to participate in co-curricular activities like debates, quizzes, essay writing, and seminars, and extra-curricular activities like sports, Youth Red Cross, NCC, and NSS for holistic development. These assessments help teachers gauge students' understanding and application of the concepts taught in each course. Semester-end examinations, as prescribed by Utkal University, serve as the primary summative assessment tool to evaluate both POs and COs. For Programme Outcomes (POs), the institution tracks student performance across all semesters, analyzing their academic progress, participation in co-curricular activities, and practical skill development through lab work, projectworks. Feedback from faculty, employers, and alumni is also considered to assess the broader impact of the programme on students' holistic development.

The results of these assessments are reviewed by the Academic Committee, which ensures continuous improvement in teaching-learning processes. Remedial actions, such as revision classes and additional assignments, are taken to address gaps in attainment, ensuring that students achieve the targeted outcomes.

Raja Madhusudhan Dev Degree College was established in the 1993-94 academic session by local residents and the governing body of the Junior College. The campus features two main gates and includes a cafeteria and a branch of Punjab National Bank. It provides well-structured and secure parking for staff and students, enhanced by a 360-degree camera at the main gate and 71 CCTV cameras across the premises. The college aims to foster a conducive learning atmosphere while contributing to environmental sustainability, boasting a well-maintained botanical garden surrounded by trees.

The campus consists of three main blocks: the Arts Block, Science Block, and a four-pillar building, housing 20 classrooms, three smart classrooms, a smart chemistry lab, and four halls equipped with projectors and Wi-Fi. The library features 13 racks catering to all departments, with online access and functional computers to support students' learning. The college includes five seminar halls, varying in capacity from 50 to 350, all equipped with projectors and AC. Additionally, seven laboratories facilitate hands-on learning. Sports facilities, including a basketball court and a football field, promote student engagement in physical activities. Overall, the college emphasizes a holistic educational experience.
